

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESSA

BY-LAW NO. 2009- 22

Being a By-law Authorizing the Mayor and the Clerk to enter into a Thirty-Four Month Service Agreement with the Ontario Clean Water Agency (OCWA) for the operation and maintenance of the Township's water treatment facility, and distribution system for the Brownley Water Treatment Plant

WHEREAS The Township of Essa is the owner of the water treatment facility known as the Brownley Water Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS the Ontario Clean Water Agency (OCWA) is in the business of providing operation and maintenance services for water facilities; and


WHEREAS the Township wishes to retain the services of OCWA to operate and maintain these facilities for the annual price as indicated in Article 4 of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS the Agreement makes provision for the possible transfer of responsibility for the facilities from the Township to another level of government within the term of this contract, should this occur as a result of a statute or government interpretation;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Essa enacts as follows:

1. That the Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a Services Agreement between the Corporation of the Township of Essa and the Ontario Clean Water Agency in the form attached hereto, and to affix the seal of the Corporation thereto.
2. This Agreement shall take effect on March 23, 2009 and shall continue in effect for an initial period 34 months until December 31, 2011, subject to Section 6.2 of the Agreement.
3. That this by-law and agreement hereby repeals and replaces any previous by-laws or agreements to this effect.

READ A FIRST, AND TAKEN AS READ A SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED on this the Eighteenth day of March 2009.
