

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESSA**

**BY-LAW NO. 2010 - 28**

**A By-law authorizing the Mayor and the Clerk to enter into an Agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Community Safety and Correctional Services and conjointly the Township of Essa, the Town of New Tecumseth, the Township of Adjala-Tosorontio and the Nottawasaga Police Services Board for the Safer Communities 1,000 Officers Partnership Program.**

WHEREAS The Township of Essa passed Resolution C341-2005 on 7 September 2005 supporting the application for the *Safer Communities – 1,000 Officers Partnership Program* for seven (7) additional officers; and


WHEREAS The Township of Adjala-Tosorontio, The Town of New Tecumseth and the Township of Essa have hereby agreed to participate and fund their respective portions for implementation of the *Safer Communities – 1000 Officers Partnership Program*; and


WHEREAS The Province of Ontario agrees to cost-share approximately 50% up to a cap of \$35,000 per officer per annum to the municipalities, to provide to the Police Services Board, so that the Board can employ new officers in full time community policing and/or targeted area activities;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Essa enacts as follows:

1. That the Mayor and the Clerk be hereby authorized to execute an Agreement between Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Community Safety and Correctional Services, the Nottawasaga Police Services Board, and the Corporation of The Town of New Tecumseth and the Corporation of The Township of Adjala-Tosorontio in the form attached hereto as Schedule “A”, and to affix the seal of the Corporation thereto.
  
3. That the Short Title of this By-law be “A By-law for Entering into an Agreement for the *Safer Communities – 1,000 Officers Partnership Program*”.

READ A FIRST, AND TAKEN AS READ A SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED on this the Twenty-First day of April 2010.
